1. The Honorable Judge Thomas A. Bishop called the meeting to order at 2:06 p.m.

3. The Committee unanimously approved the minutes of the meeting held on December 7, 2016.
4. The Committee continued its consideration of proposals to Article VIII—Hearsay, which were presented by Judge Ecker and Attorney Adelman. The Committee considered comments by Attorneys Adelman and Steigelfest regarding a proposal to amend Sec. 8-3 (1). Attorney Steigelfest will draft language for the commentary for presentation at the next meeting. Judge Ecker will continue the presentation of Article VIII at the next meeting.
5. After discussion, the next meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, March 1, 2017, in the Supreme Court courtroom at 2:00 p.m.
