

Minutes of the Meeting
Juvenile Task Force
August 26, 2010

On Thursday, August 26, 2010 the Delinquency Subcommittee of the Juvenile Task Force met in the [Superior Court for Juvenile Matters at Hartford](#), 920 Broad Street, 4th floor, Courtroom C, Hartford from 2:00 p.m. to approximately 2:50 p.m.

The members discussed the agenda items in the following order:

1. The members discussed the proposed revision to Section 30-5 and agreed that subsection (a)(1) should be revised to include delinquent children. The members also agreed that a new subsection (c) should be drafted to address children held in detention pursuant to the Interstate Compact on Juveniles. Judicial staff will revise the Section and redistribute it to the members by email for further comment.

2. The members agreed to ask the Victim Advocate to draft a proposed rule with commentary to address the possibility of appointing GALs for victims in delinquency cases.

3. The members unanimously approved the proposed revisions to Section 26-1.

4. The members decided not to pursue the Victim Advocate's suggestion for non-judicial handling criteria. The members agreed that such criteria would require a statutory change to Gen. Stat. Sec. 46b-38c.

5. Other Business addressed included the following two items: (1) The members approved the minutes of the Task Force meeting held on May 11, 2009; and (2) The members unanimously approved changes to Section 30-6 that Fran Carino drafted and proposed. The changes reflect the changed findings and grounds required for detention by Public Act 09-7 of the September Special Session.

6. Judge Keller stated that the members of the subcommittee will communicate by email on outstanding agenda items.

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
