



# The Connecticut Judicial Branch **Job Shadow Program**

February 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup>



## The Judicial Branch offers students the opportunity to shadow workplace hosts in courts and other Judicial Branch facilities during the workday.

This program is offered from February to April every year.

The Job Shadow program allows high school students to explore career interests and vocational skills by shadowing a Judicial Branch employee during a portion of the workday.

Students are matched with a mentor in his or her area of interest at a location as near as possible to each student's school.

To allow students enough time to explore their areas of interest and receive one-on-one instruction, only one student per position per day will be accepted. However, multiple students from the same school may shadow different hosts at the same judicial facility on the same day.
