

PROPOSED DISPOSITION PURSUANT TO PRACTICE BOOK § 2-82(b)

Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(b), and Practice Book § 2-82(a)(2), the undersigned Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate and agree as follows:


1. Eroll Skyers (hereinafter Respondent), Juris number 407152, was admitted to the bar of the State of Connecticut on December 14, 1992 and has a history of discipline of five prior reprimands in the matters of 96-0593; 01-0276; 01-0383; 01-0471 and 07-0022.
2. The Respondent has registered with the Statewide Grievance Committee for 2010 and is currently in good standing.
3. This matter was instituted by grievance complaint dated June 29, 2009.
4. On December 15, 2009, the Fairfield Judicial District Grievance Panel found probable cause that the Respondent violated Rules 8.4(3) and 8.4(4) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.
5. The Respondent has tendered an affidavit pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(d) attached hereto, and admits that he was contacted by James Streeto, his file was requested and he did not provide the file pursuant to that request and that this conduct violated Rule(s) 8.4(3) and 8.4(4) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.
6. Pursuant to the request of the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, the Respondent has provided his full file to the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel.
7. The Complainant has signed a release and authorization for the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel to provide the full file to his present lawyer.

- 8. The Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel agree that the Respondent will be reprimanded pursuant to Practice Book §2-37(a).
- 9. The Respondent and the Disciplinary Counsel agree that the Disciplinary Counsel will recommend that the Statewide Grievance Committee impose the sanction set forth in this agreement. If this agreement is rejected by the Statewide Grievance Committee, the Disciplinary Counsel will pursue this matter at a contested hearing.


WHEREFORE, this matter is submitted to the Statewide Grievance Committee for its approval in accordance with Practice Book § 2-82(b).



I am over the age of 18 and believe in the obligation of an oath. Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(d), I make the following affidavit:


1. The Proposed Disposition attached hereto and made a part hereof is voluntarily submitted.
