Going strong for five years now, Connecticut high school students and members of various organizations have participated in the presentations offered by the Jury Outreach Program. We ensure that more people understand the importance of jury duty, one of the greatest responsibilities of citizenship. We have visited over **130** high schools and organizations throughout Connecticut and conducted nearly **650** presentations in front of well over **18,000** people (see page 2 for Cumulative Statistics). This illustrates the commitment that leaders like you and the Jury Outreach Program staff have made to not only helping people understand the importance of jury duty, but explaining that it is the backbone of our legal system.

In addition to the high school presentations, the Jury Outreach Team has presented in front of Rotarians, senior citizens, college students, Adult Education programs, middle school students, and elementary students. The team members have also participated in many community events, including the Laurel Girls State, Grandparents Day Family Fair, The West Caribbean Celebration, and various events at the Salvation Army.

The success of the Jury Outreach Program is possible because of the enormous commitment made by educators and leaders throughout Connecticut. Our goal is to continue this innovative program and reach more high school students and adults next year.

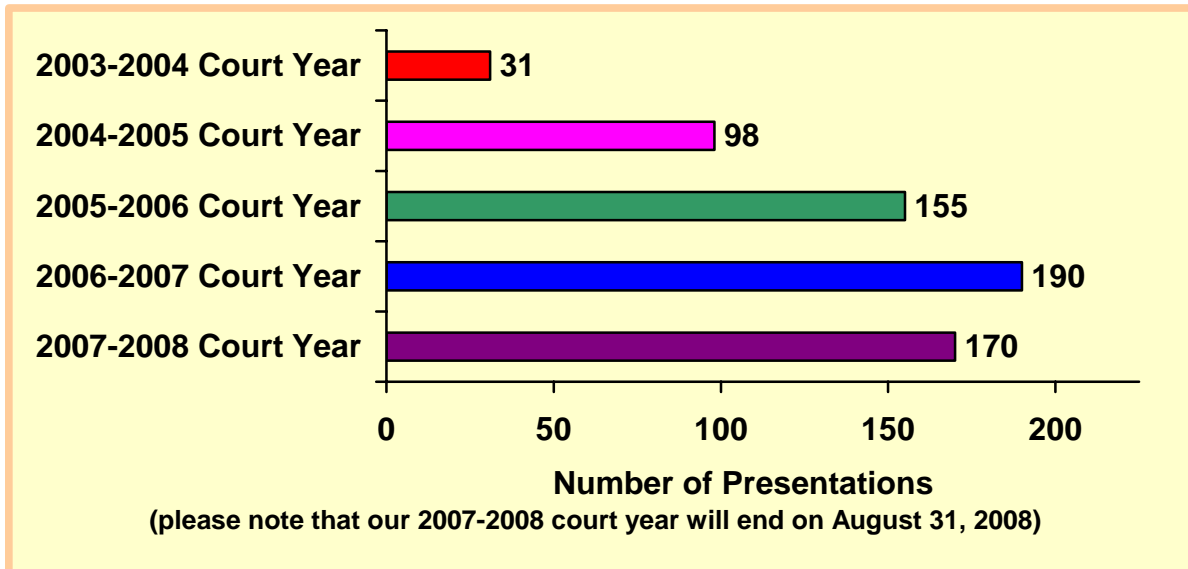

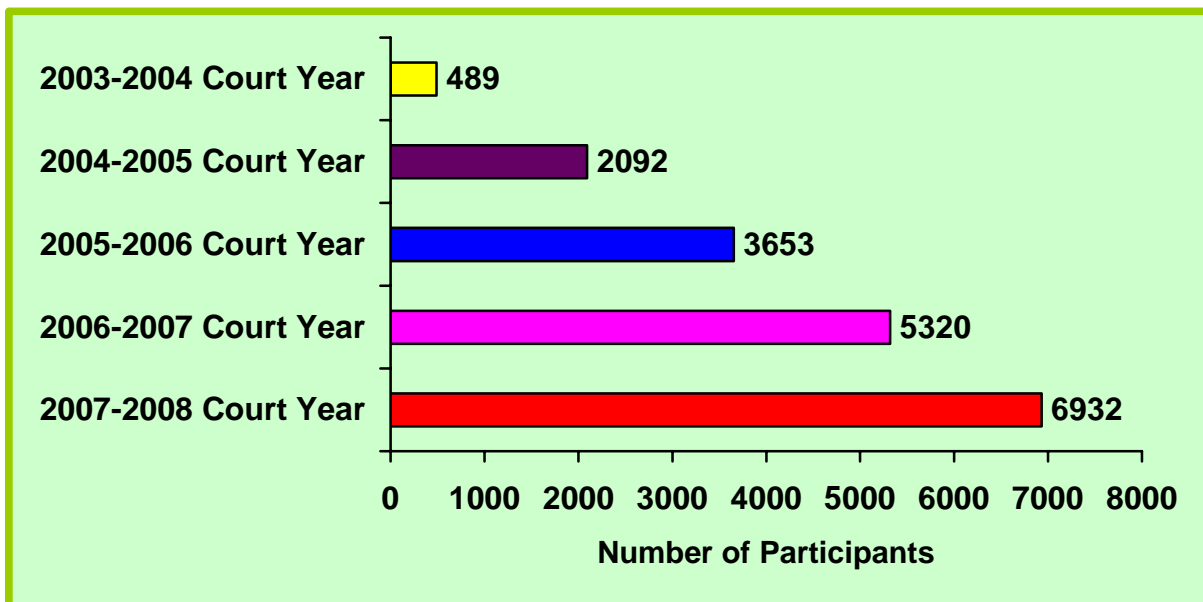
