

Notice Regarding the Client Security Fund Fee

Invoices for the 2018 client security fund fee have been mailed to attorneys licensed to practice in Connecticut who are required to pay the fee pursuant to Practice Book Section 2-70, to authorized house counsel required to pay the fee pursuant to Practice Book Section 2-15A, and to attorneys permitted to appear *pro hac vice* pursuant to Practice Book Section 2-16. **The fee for 2018 is \$75.00**, and is due **June 15, 2018**. The fee may be paid by mail with the invoice or online by credit card or through a checking account by attorneys who have registered with the Judicial Branch for E-Services at <http://www.jud.ct.gov/external/super/E-Services/efile/>. Please note that there is a service fee for credit card payments. Attorneys who do not receive an invoice or who misplace their invoice and do not wish to pay the fee online may obtain an invoice by logging in to E-Services, selecting "Client Security Fund Fee," then "Pay By Mail."
