

Court Operations' Performance Management, Quality Assurance and Judicial Branch Statistics Unit Recognized Nationally for Continued Excellence

The Connecticut Judicial Branch recently received the 2022 Award for Continued Excellence in statistical data reporting from the Conference of State Court Administrators (COSCA) and the National Center for State Courts (NCSC). The continued excellence award is a new award to recognize a state that has shown consistent excellence in data reporting over multiple years. Connecticut is the first state to receive this recognition.

Connecticut also received Reporting Excellence Awards from COSCA/NCSC in 2016 and 2017, for the trial court and appellate court, respectively. Led by Director Joe Greelish, the Branch's Performance Management, Quality Assurance and Judicial Branch Statistics Unit is responsible for preparing and reporting the data.

The Conference of State Court Administrators is an organization consisting of the chief court administrators of all 50 states. It was established to provide an effective network for the exchange of information, ideas, and methods to improve state courts. The National Center for State Courts is a not-for-profit independent organization that promotes the rule of law and improving the administration of justice in state courts through gathering information and producing innovative solutions.
