

The Notice:

Judges will continue to rule on all civil short calendar motions that print on Short Calendar 10 (Non-arguable calendar) and all Indical calendars. Motions on those calendars that are marked “take papers” will continue to be taken on the papers and arguable motions marked “ready” on Indical calendars will continue to be scheduled for a remote hearing. **Do not come to court on the date of the short calendar.**

Beginning with the September 8, 2020 calendar, Short Calendar 03 (Special Proceedings/PJR) will resume, and all motions on that calendar that are marked “take papers” will be ruled on by the Court on the papers. Motions marked “ready” will be scheduled for a remote hearing at a later date. **Do not come to court on the date of the short calendar.**

Attorneys are required to mark their motions electronically unless they have an exemption from e-filing. Self-represented parties and e-filing exempt attorneys can call in their markings to the number listed on the calendar notice. We continue to appreciate your patience as we expand civil court business during these unprecedented times.
