Mission

The Connecticut Judicial Branch created the Speakers Bureau in 1996 to provide an opportunity for judges and other court officials to address community groups, civic organizations and schools about the state court system and to receive feedback from members of the public about issues of concern. This program and similar efforts are offered to the public to increase its awareness and understanding of the Connecticut court system. The Connecticut Judicial Branch is committed to developing and participating in public education programs such as the Speakers Bureau.

Since the program's inception, the Speakers Bureau has addressed *over 50,000* individuals from a variety of organizations.

Overview

Judges will discuss what motivated them to pursue judgeships, their different experiences on the bench and how their personal and professional lives have changed. Additionally, they will discuss their challenges and their most interesting cases. Judges will also answer questions and engage in a dialogue.
