NOTICE TO APPLICANTS REGARDING COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS FOR THE JULY 2022 CONNECTICUT BAR EXAMINATION

The July 2022 administration of the Connecticut bar examination will be an in-person examination administered on July 26 - 27, 2022, at the Connecticut Convention Center in Hartford. There will be no remote option. The Connecticut Bar Examining Committee is committed to the safety and health of its examinees, proctors, and staff. The CBEC will be closely monitoring COVID-19 health and safety requirements and these current protocols are subject to change between now and the date of the July 2022 bar examination based on CDC guidelines and/or requirements imposed by federal, state, and local authorities.

- 1) All candidates for the July 2022 bar examination are required to wear masks upon arrival and at all times during the entire examination. Masks must be worn properly, securely covering the mouth and nose. Please review the CDC guide for masks: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/masks.html>. Proctors may ask applicants to remove their mask briefly to confirm their identity.
- 2) Applicants are required to self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19. If an applicant has current COVID-19 symptoms, has tested positive for COVID-19 within five days prior to the exam, is waiting for COVID-19 test results, or has been exposed to COVID-19 and has been advised to quarantine by a health professional, the applicant is prohibited from coming to the examination site or sitting for the examination.

Withdrawal and Credit of Application Fee:

Any candidate who cannot comply with the COVID-19 precautions for the July 2022 bar examination may withdraw their application and may be entitled to a fee credit towards a future bar examination under Article III-3 of the CBEC Regulations.
