

**Amendment to Canon 3 (b) (3) of the Code of Judicial Conduct Effective August 1, 2008:**

“(3) A judge should take or initiate appropriate disciplinary measures against a judge or lawyer for unprofessional conduct of which the judge may become aware. A judge is not required to disclose information gained by the judge while serving as a member of a committee that renders assistance to ill or impaired judges or lawyers or while serving as a member of a bar association professional ethics committee or the Judicial Branch Committee on Judicial Ethics.” (New language is underlined.)

**Amendment to Rule 8.3 of the Rules of Professional Conduct Effective August 1, 2008:**

“(c) This Rule does not require disclosure of information otherwise protected by Rule 1.6 or General Statutes § 51-81d (f) or obtained while serving as a member of a bar association ethics committee or the Judicial Branch Committee on Judicial Ethics.” (New language is underlined.)
