

**THE SUPREME COURT IS SOLICITING AMICUS CURIAE BRIEFS IN:**

**JESSICA BILBAO v. TIMOTHY GOODWIN, SC 20078**

This appeal was filed with the Appellate Court on October 30, 2017, and was transferred to the Supreme Court on March 8, 2018. The Court invites amici curiae to file briefs that address the following question:

"Did the trial court properly award the cryopreserved embryos to the plaintiff wife under a "balancing approach"; see *Davis v. Davis*, 842 S.W.2d 588 (Tenn. 1992); after declining to apply a "contract approach" on the ground that the parties' agreement with the reproductive services center was not an enforceable contract? See *Bilbao v. Goodwin*, Superior Court, judicial district of Hartford, Docket No. FA-16-6071615-S (October 24, 2017, *Nastri, J.*) (65 Conn. L. Rptr. 357) (2017 WL 5642280)."

As this is a court-initiated request, an application for permission to file as amicus curiae is not required. If you accept the Court's invitation, you must file the amicus brief limited to 10 pages on or before April 22, 2019, in compliance with Practice Book Section 67-7, including the disclosure required in the first footnote on the first page of text. No oral argument, responsive briefs or extensions of time will be allowed.
