The Supreme Court is Soliciting Amicus Briefs in:

Jennyah Georges PPA Maria Leoma and Jean Georges et al v. OB-GYN Services, PC et al., SC 20170

This appeal was filed on September 8, 2018, after grant of certification by the Supreme Court and is scheduled to be argued before the Supreme Court on October 23, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. The Court invites amici curiae to file briefs that address the following question:

"Did the Appellate Court properly dismiss as untimely the portion of the defendants' December 16, 2016 appeal challenging the October 28, 2016 judgment on the jury verdict for the plaintiff, where the defendants argue (1) that the appeal period was extended under Practice Book § 63-1 (c) (1) by the November 8, 2016 filing of the plaintiff's motion for offer of compromise interest and that their appeal was timely because it was filed within twenty days of the trial court's December 12, 2016 ruling on the motion and (2) that, in the alternative, the trial court did not render an appealable final judgment until it ruled on the plaintiff's motion for offer of compromise interest? "

As this is a court-initiated request, an application for permission to file as amicus curiae is not required. If you accept the Court's invitation, you must file the amicus brief limited to 10 pages on or before September 30, 2019, in compliance with practice book P.B. § 67-7, including the disclosure required in the first footnote on the first page of text. No oral argument, responsive briefs or extensions of time will be allowed.
