The Supreme Court is Soliciting Amicus Briefs in:

*Joseph Halladay v. Commissioner of Correction; SC 20369*

This appeal was filed October 11, 2019, after a grant of certification by the Supreme Court. The brief of the appellant is presently due on or before November 25, 2019. The Court invites amici curiae to file briefs that address the following questions:

- "1. Did the Appellate Court properly dismiss the petitioner's appeal for lack of a final judgment?
- "2. If the answer to the first question is 'no,' did the trial court properly reject the petitioner's claim of privilege in his attorney's case file?"

As this is a court-initiated request, an application for permission to file as amicus curiae is not required. If you accept the Court's invitation, you must file the amicus brief in compliance with Practice Book section 67-7, including the disclosure required in the first footnote on the first page of text, on or before twenty days after the filing of the brief of the party, if any, whom the amicus intends to support, and if there is no such party, then the brief shall be filed no later than twenty days after the filing to the appellee's brief. No oral argument, responsive briefs or extensions of time will be allowed.
