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TAYLOR v. WINSTED MEMORIAL HOSPITAL—CONCURRENCE

SULLIVAN, C. J., with whom ZARELLA, J., joins, concurring. I agree with the majority's conclusion. I disagree, however, with the majority's approach to statutory interpretation. My view on the appropriate method of statutory interpretation continues to be the same as set forth in my concurrence in *Mandell v. Gavin*, 262 Conn. 659, 672, A.2d (2003), and in the dissenting opinion by Justice Zarella, in which I joined, in *State v. Courchesne*, 262 Conn. 537, 597, A.2d (2003).
