

**Superior Court for Family Matters
Standing Order – Motion to Waive Statutory Waiting
Period – Section 46b-67 (b) of the Connecticut
General Statutes**

Section 46b-67 (b) of the Connecticut General Statutes allows the parties to make a motion requesting a waiver of the statutory waiting period prior to entry of a decree of dissolution or legal separation set forth in section 46b-67 (a). Any such motion filed will not be placed on the short calendar, but shall be brought by the clerk as soon as practicable to either the judge assigned to hear the case, or, if a judge has not yet been assigned, to the presiding judge for a ruling on the papers. If granted, the uncontested dissolution is to be scheduled in accordance with the request of the parties to the degree that such request can be accommodated, including scheduling the matter on the same day that the motion is granted.
