Notice is also hereby given that effective February 1st all parties with cases assigned to the Complex Litigation Docket (CLD) shall use the revised *Request for Adjudication – Complex Litigation Docket (CLD)*, form JD-CL-77. A motion or objection must be docketed through the filing of the revised *Request for Adjudication* form in order for the motion or objection to be considered by the court. In all cases that require e-filing, *Requests for Adjudication* shall be e-filed and the filer shall select “Request for Adjudication Complex Litigation” when naming the form in e-filing.
