Instructions to applicant

- 1. Before you can ask the court to terminate (end) the order, you must wait 180 days from:

- The date the court first continued your Risk Protection Order; or
 The date that the court denied your last petition to end your Risk Protection Order
 Complete the Petition section and file it with the clerk of court in the GA where the first Risk Protection Order hearing was held.

- Upon receipt of a Petition, submit it to a Judge for entry of the order requiring the law enforcement agency to investigate.
 Schedule a hearing on the 28th day following the filing of the petition and provide the petitioner with a copy of the order with the hearing date.
 Forward the Petition and Order of the Court to Justice Support, the State's Attorney's Office, and the law enforcement agency finds, after investigation, no probable cause to believe the petition poses a risk, submit the Law Enforcement Agency Notice

Order of the Court (if law enforcement agency found no probable cause) After receiving notice that the law enforcement agency found, after an investigation, that there is no probable cause to believe that the petitioner poses a risk of imminent personal injury to himself, herself, or another person, the court cancels the hearing and terminates the Risk Protection Order. The court further orders that any firearms, deadly weapons, or ammunition seized pursuant to a Search and Seizure Warrant in connection with the Risk Protection Order be returned to the respondent as soon as is practicable, provided that the respondent is otherwise legally able to possess these items. If the respondent does not claim the firearms, deadly weapons, or ammunition within 6 months, the court orders the seized property to be turned over to the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection for appropriate use or destruction. This order does not overrule, replace, or supersede any determination by the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection as to whether the respondent is eligible to possess the seized property.
